## HOW WILL TIME FOR ENGAGEMENT IN GMGY IMPLEMENTATION BE ALLOCATED?

To facilitate Phase 1 of GMGY Implementation over the next two years, Community National Schools are advised to dedicate time for all CNS teachers to engage in GMGY Professional Development. In addition, schools are requested to make provision for their GMGY Coordinator to attend additional training on leading GMGY Implementation locally. The following table outlines the minimum recommended hours to facilitate GMGY professional development as well as the recommended means of provision for those hours. Schools can use this table as a reference when allocating time for GMGY professional development from September 2020-June 2022.
