

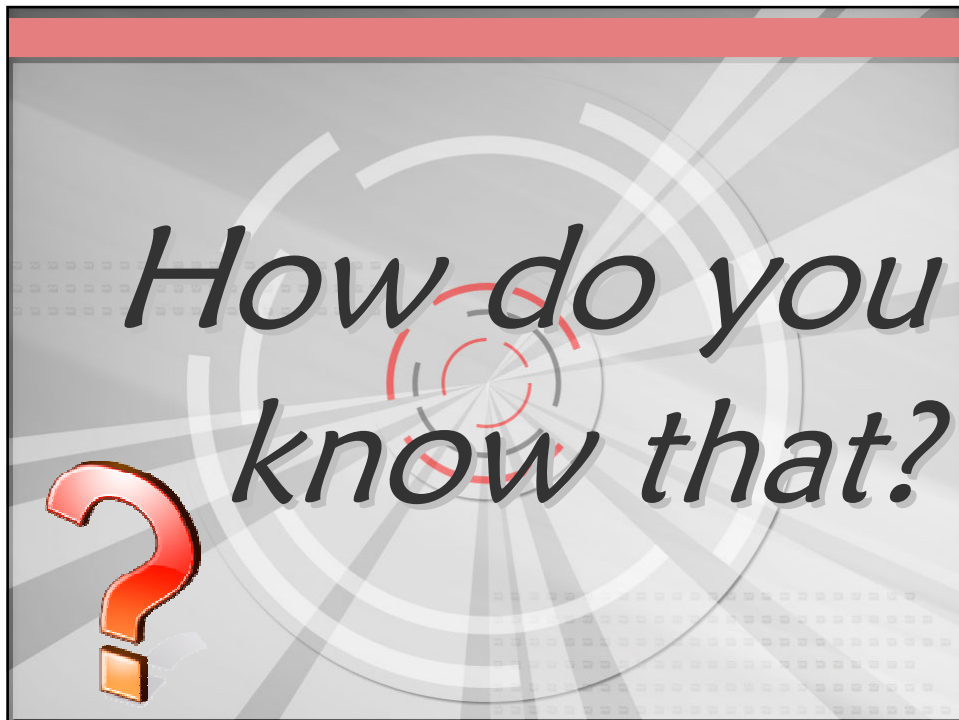
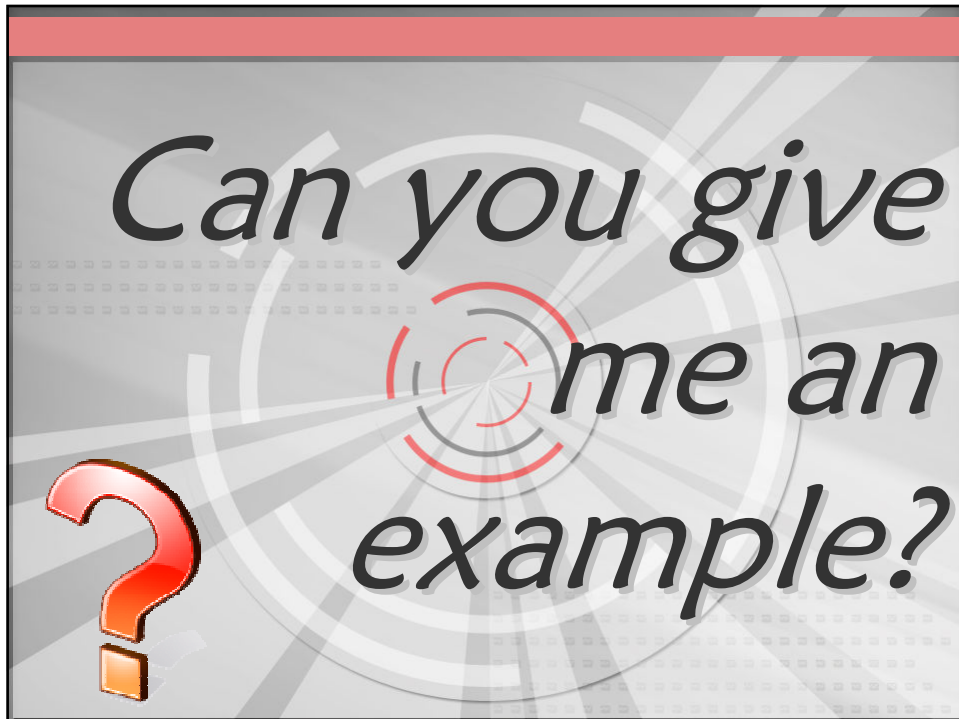

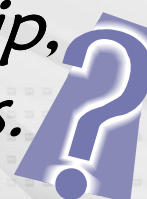




*We learn to **listen**

thoughtful.

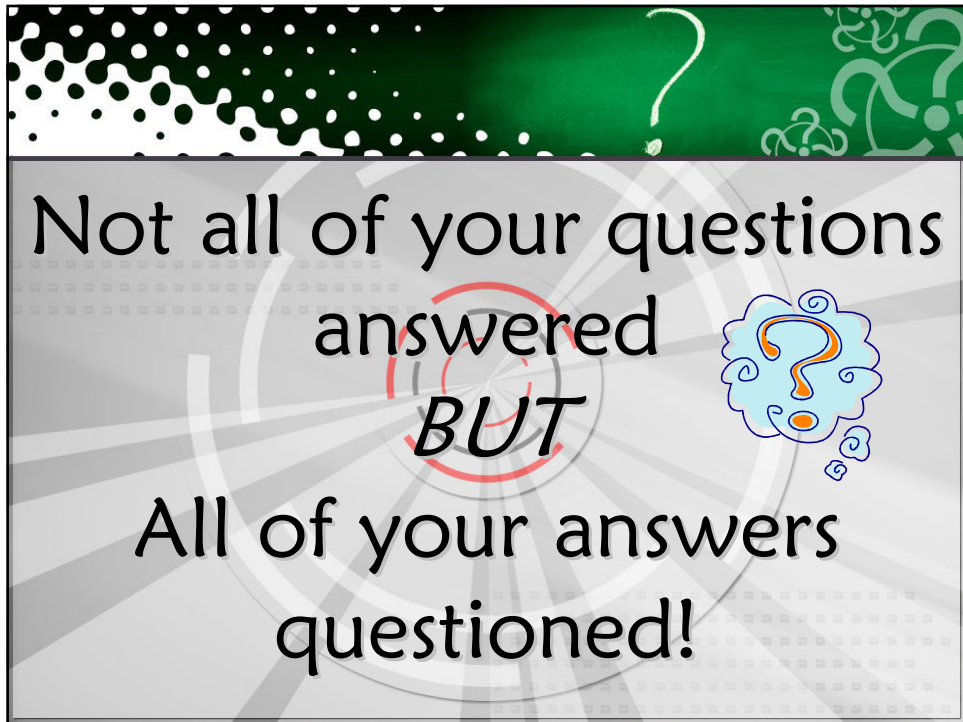




We care more about what others say but we don't accept easy answers.
